What are the laundry and housekeeping services like?

Finances & Contracts

What is the total cost of care?
What payment options are accepted? Does the facility accept
Medicare, Medicaid, or long-term care insurance?
What is the admission process like?
What is the discharge policy?
Can I review a sample contract?

Observe the Environment

Pay attention to the atmosphere. Does it feel warm, welcoming, and clean? Are the residents engaged and interacting with staff?

Observe the staff's interactions with residents. Are they respectful, patient, and compassionate?

Check the cleanliness and maintenance of the facility. Are the common areas and resident rooms well-maintained? Are there any unpleasant odors?

Notice the safety features. Are there grab bars in the bathrooms? Are the hallways well-lit and free of clutter?
